There will be an early dismissal this Thursday at 11:30. The teachers will attend an afternoon in-service at Area 11 in Johnston.

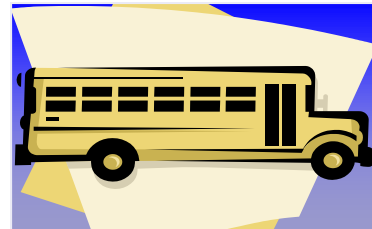
Progress reports will be sent home on Friday, the 23rd. Please sign and return to school. If you have any questions, please give the teacher a call.

No school on October 6 and 7.

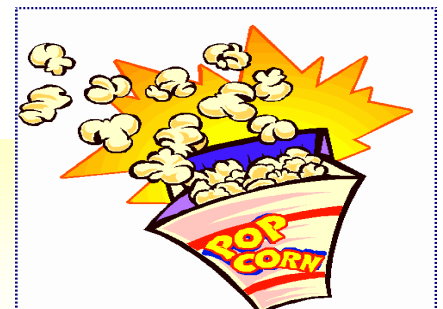


Library News
