Parent/Teacher Conferences Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, November 1 & 2.

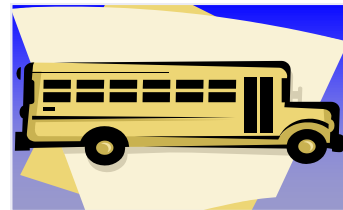
Everyone is invited to attend the Junior High Music Festival at the Pella Christian High School auditorium Thursday evening, November 3.
